Building Tips

- Make sure the firm or individual is fully licensed to operate in the State of Michigan. <u>Ask to see their license</u>.
- Under the law, (2008) unlicensed individuals acting in the capacity of a residential builder or a residential maintenance and alteration contractor will immediately face stronger penalties.

A first offense will be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$5,000.00 or more than \$25,000.00, or imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both. A second or subsequent offense will be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$5,000.00 or more than \$25,000.00, or imprisonment for not more than 2 years, or both. An offense that causes death or serious injury, a felony punishable by a fine of not less than \$5,000.00 or more then \$25,000.00, or imprisonment for not more than 4 years, or both.

- Did you know that in the State of Michigan any residential work performed OVER \$600.00 WITHOUT PROPER LICENSING, voids contractual agreements and monies need not be paid for that work?
- Did you know that in the case of a worker being injured on your property without proper insurance YOU could be held personally liable? You could be sued.
- Make sure the firm or individual provides proof of Worker's Compensation Insurance, Personal Liability and Property Insurance, NOT the individual's medical, health or auto insurance.
- Make sure the firm or individual is reputable. They should provide satisfactory references. CALL THEM!

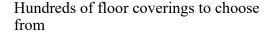

- Where should the fire in your fireplace be built?On the andirons or grate, never on the fireplace floor
- 10. What will prevent soot and add color to the fire in your fireplace? Throw in a handful of salt
- 11. Where should your firewood be stored?

 Outside away from your house and not directly on the ground
- 12. What helps keep unpainted concrete floors easy to keep clean?

 Concrete sealer
- **13.** What should you use to clean unpainted concrete floors?

 A solution of 4 to 6 tablespoons of washing soda in a gallon of hot water
- 14. When can you clean hardwood floors with water?
 When the floors have a polyurethane finish
- 15. Do hardwood floors need to be waxed?

Hardwoods floors that do not have a polyurethane finish probably will need to be waxed periodically. Use liquid or paste "spirit" wax.

16. What is the best polish for vinyl floors?

Water emulsion wax

17. Why should noisy water pipes be fixed promptly?

The condition that causes noisy pipes may be accompanied with vibration that can cause fittings to loosen and leak

18. Why should frozen pipes be thawed slowly?

To prevent the formation of steam, which would cause the pipe to burst

19. How often should your roof be inspected?

A qualified roofer should inspect your roof every three years

20. To ensure your safety, what household equipment uses batteries that must be checked regularly to make sure they are operable? Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors

21. At what temperature should your hot water heater be set? 120 degrees Fahrenheit

22. How often do skylights need to be inspected?

Skylights should be inspected each time your roof is inspected so leaks do not develop from cracks and interruptions around its seals, caulking and flashing

23. What is a simple solution you can use to wash extremely dirty exterior windows?

A solution of equal parts vinegar and water or 3 tablespoons of denatured alcohol per quart of warm water. Use a piece of crumpled newspaper to avoid lint left behind by paper towels

24. What can you use to help a window slide easily? Rub the channel with a piece of paraffin

25. What should you look for when you inspect your siding yearly? Determine if wood-sided homes need to be repainted; check to see if the caulking around the window and doors has split and cracked, and replace the caulk; clean the mildew; trim shrubbery away so it does not touch the siding

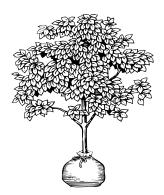

Increasing Professionalism: (effective June 1, 2008)

Q. I'm applying for my license for the first time. Can I take the 4-hour course advertised in the newspaper?

A. No. You have to successfully complete 60 hours of pre-licensure education courses before you will be allowed to take the test.

Q. What do I have to study?

A. At least six hours in each of the following areas of competency: Business Management; Estimating, and Job Costing; Design and Building Science; Contracts, Liability and Risk Management; Marketing and Sales; Project Management and Scheduling; the current Michigan Residential Code and Construction Safety Standards promulgated under the Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Act. Each class would have to be approved by the Department of Labor and Economic Growth (DLEG). Education courses offered as a part of the National Association of Home Builder's University of Housing curriculum are already approved by law.

Q. Once I have my license, what do I need to do to keep it?

A. That depends on how long you have had it. For the first six years you're licensed, you'll have to successfully complete at least three hours of activities demonstrating continuing competency each calendar year, during the first six years of licensure, and a total of 21 hours per three-year time period since the issuance of your license. At least three hours would have to be devoted to activities designed to develop your understanding of and ability to apply state building codes and laws relating to the licensed occupation, safety, and changes in construction and business management laws. You'll also need to always have a copy of the current edition of the Michigan Residential Code.

Q. Is "continuing competency" the same thing as "continuing education?"

A. No. While taking approved courses or participating in distance learning are two ways of showing continuing competency, some other ways you can also show continuing competency are through comprehensive testing, participation in mentoring programs, participation in International Codes Council code hearings, publication of articles in a trade journal or regional magazine and serving as a lecturer or discussion leader in an approved educational course. These methods must be approved by DLEG and records of the activities must be kept by the licensee for five years.

Look for a Professional

In the market for a new home or remodeling? Finding just the right house and making it into a home can be one of the most rewarding experiences you will ever have. But equally important is choosing a builder who is a professional.

Only you can decide which builder is right for you. Finding someone whose work you can trust can make a difference between a happy and an unhappy homeowner.

Here are some guidelines to help you in your search:

- 1. Talk to others who have purchased a home or had remodeling from your builder. Find out from them what they think of the builder's service and post-sale performance.
- Ask your builder how he stands behind his work. If he offers a
 warranty, ask him what it covers and does not cover. If the
 warranty is limited to corrections of structural faults and material
 failures, understand that routine maintenance is not covered.
- A guarantee that the contractor carries liability insurance and has Worker's Compensation coverage, in case of accidents on the job. Be sure your contractor has a permanent business location and a phone number.
- 4. Find out how long your builder has been in business. Your bank may also be a source of information to you. Contact your local home builder's association to ask if your builder is a member in good standing.

5. **GET ESTIMATES**

- ▶ Get estimates from different contractors to compare prices. Remember the cost of materials and their quality will affect the bid. A low bid based on inferior materials may not be any bargain, so consider more than the price alone.
- ▶ Be sure all contractors have the same exact specifications and are all bidding on the same things.

6. GET IT IN WRITING

- ▶ When you have selected a contractor, get all agreements in writing. A written agreement will make sure there are no misunderstandings about the work or the terms of the contract.
- ▶ Make sure that you read all documents carefully.

- ▶ Do not be afraid to ask questions about anything you do not understand. Ask for any changes or modifications before you sign the contract.
- ▶ Time and Material (T&M) or "Full Contract". Time and material is strictly that: you pay the contractor an hourly wage for his time, no matter how long it takes, and for the materials. The bottom line is not exactly known. A full contract includes all aspects of the job: labor, materials, specifications, payment schedule, etc. for one sum. You know exactly what the job will cost you.
- ▶ Remodeling projects can be difficult to bid. A contractor doesn't always know what he will find behind that wall, roof, ceiling, etc. Some contractors will specify that if an unknown conditions arises, it will be considered an "extra" and a change order will be provided to the owner for their approval of the added cost. Or an "allowance" for that particular item may be in your contract. In other words, you are allowed X-amount of dollars for this item. If the remodel, repairs, etc. goes over that amount, then you are responsible for the added cost. If the remodel, repairs, etc. were less than the amount, you should receive a credit.

7. GET A CONTRACT

The written contract should include:

- ▶ The company name, address, phone number, and the full name and license number of the builder/contractor and the salesperson.
- ▶ Detailed job specifications which include a description (brand names, colors, grades, model numbers) of materials, a list of all costs spelled out clearly, and any architect's or engineer's drawings which are required.
- ► Start and completion dates. These should allow for any reasonable delays.
- ▶ A statement that all required building permits and variances will be obtained by the contractor before work is begun. The building permit is for your protection. An inspector will make sure the finished job meets all codes and safety standards, and makes the contractor responsible for corrections.
- ▶ A statement of warranty on the work. Be sure it tells if labor and materials are guaranteed, and for how long. A statement that cleanup will be done by the contractor should be included.
- ▶ A provision for credits if there are large amounts of material leftover. On the other hand, you should be prepared to pay for extra materials if the project takes more than anticipated. Your builder should provide you with a description of these extra costs in writing, so that there are no surprises on your final bill.
- ► The terms of the payment should be clearly stated in the contract.
- ▶ A right to cancel clause. If you are solicited and signed the

contract in your home, you have three days in which you can cancel if you change your mind. You must send the contractor a registered letter stating you wish to cancel.

- ▶ If everything in the agreement is satisfactory, both the contractor and the homeowners must sign and date the contract. Any later changes or revisions must be dated and initialed by both parties.
- ▶ Be sure that the contractor gives you a copy of the contract, with any changes noted.

8. **RESOLVING PROBLEMS**

- ▶ Ask your builder to explain what you should do if you discover a problem in your home. He should provide the telephone number of a person to contact if you have a problem. Ask what will be covered and for how long. Get tips on routine and preventive maintenance from your builder.
- ▶ If you have problems, you should first try to resolve them with the contractor before making the final payment. You may contact the local building inspector for assistance in resolving workmanship and code violations.

OTHER TIPS

- ▶ Never pay for the entire job in advance.
- ▶ Make a deposit when work begins to cover materials and startup costs. Pay by check to the company name and always get a receipt.
- ► Make scheduled payments as work progresses.
- ▶ Be sure that any work which requires a permit, such as plumbing, electrical, heating, or structural has been approved by the state or local building inspector.

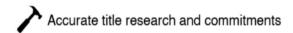


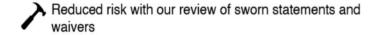

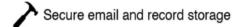

Licensing information from Michigan.gov

You should be aware that all contractors offering to do work which totals \$600 or more in labor and materials must be licensed by the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. A Residential Builders license allows a contractor to build a complete residential structure and to do maintenance & alteration (remodeling) work on a residential structure. A Maintenance & Alteration license indicates that the holder has met requirements for one or more of the following trades:

Basement waterproofing
Concrete
House wrecking
Masonry
Screen and storm sash
Carpentry
Excavation
Insulation
Roofing
Gutters

Siding Swimming pools

Tile and marble

The trades for which a maintenance & alteration contractor is qualified to practice are listed on the license.

The holders state license must be displayed in the place of business and all contractors and their salespersons must carry a pocket card which you should ask to see. If they cannot show you a license, check the department's License Information database or call the Licensing Division at 517-373-8068.
